Thanks to research by Lisa Diane Hitz Wicks (1-10-6-5-2-2-1-3), Diane Elizabeth Bowman Feite (1-10-6-5-2-2-3), and Steven Alfred Feite (1-10-6-5-2-2-3-1), we now know that all the descendants of John George Enders (1-7) are also descended from a Revolutionary War soldier named John Bowman who served in Capt. Jonathan McClure's company of Lancaster County, PA. He was born April 14, 1752 and died Oct. 14, 1797. His daughter, Catharine Bowman, who was born during the war on Nov. 12, 1778, married John George Enders (1-7). Thus the whole 1-7 line descends from a Revolutionary War soldier. Even if you are not a 1-7, if you have Bowman lineage, you might still descend from John Bowman whose children are Catharine, Jacob, John, George, Peter, Henry, and Barbara.
